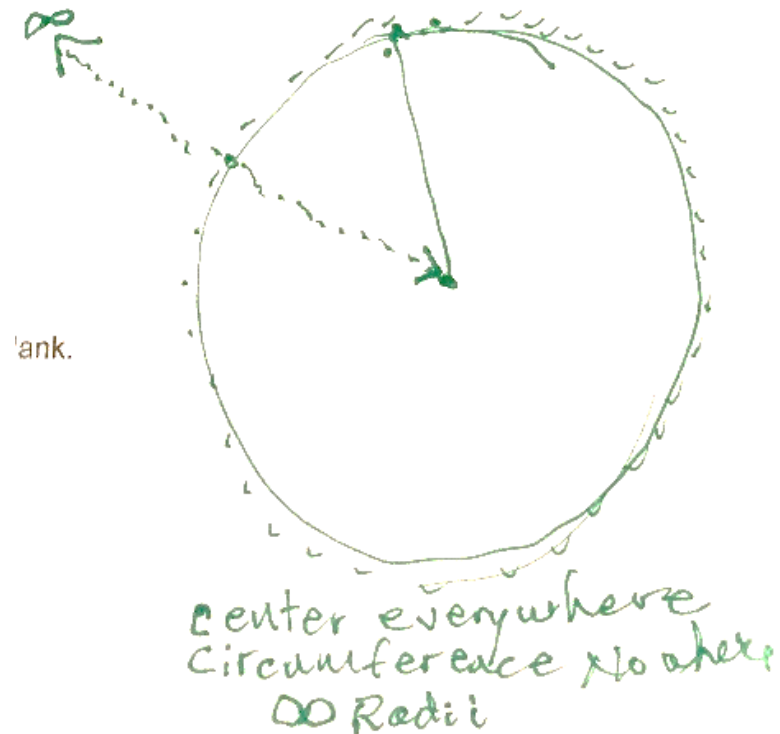


# CIRCLE BOUNDARY AND INFINITY

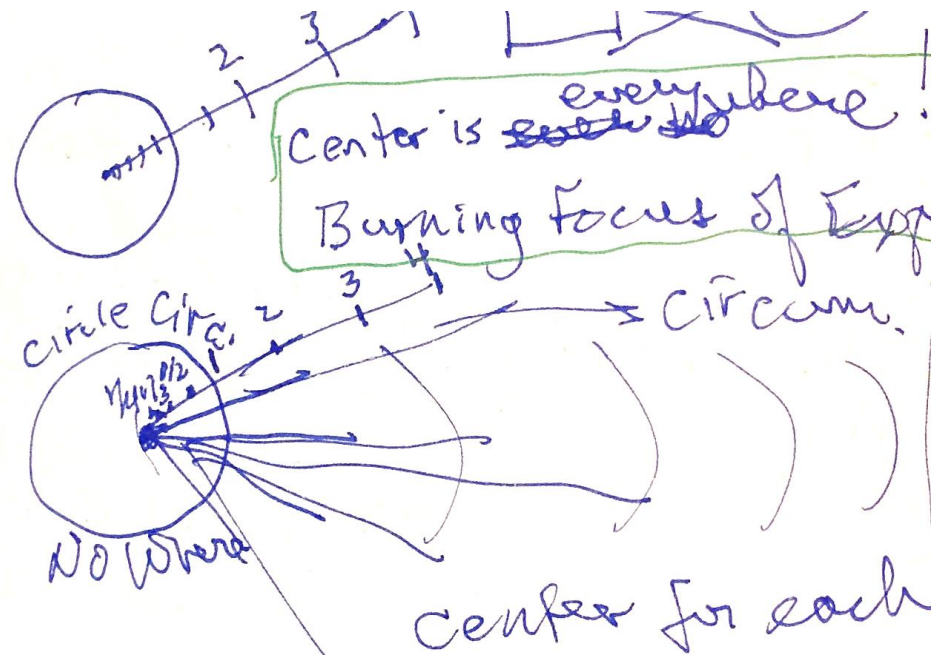
# **INVERSION: circle relates the POINT and the INFINITE SPACE..**

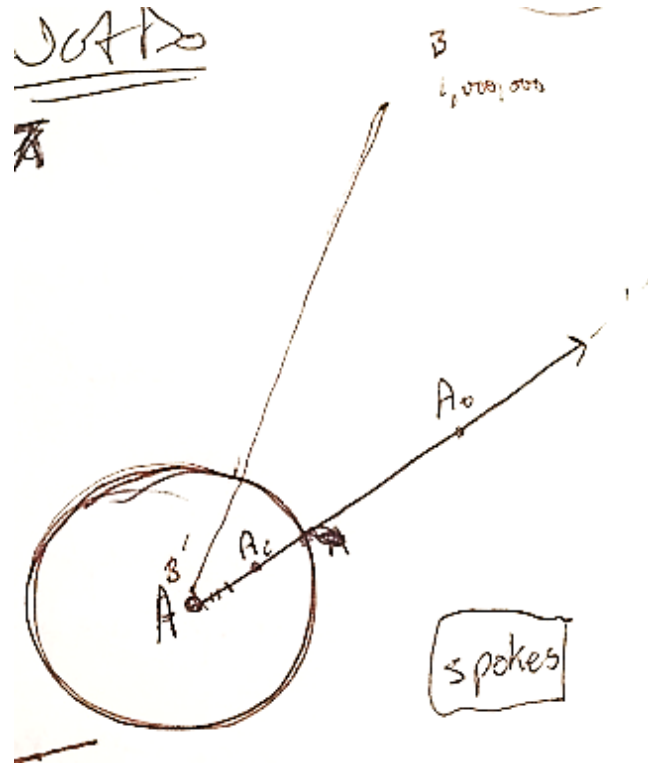
Circle expands to become a line at infinity. The radiating movement of the circle from the center. The circle can be expanded to infinity: a circle at infinity. "

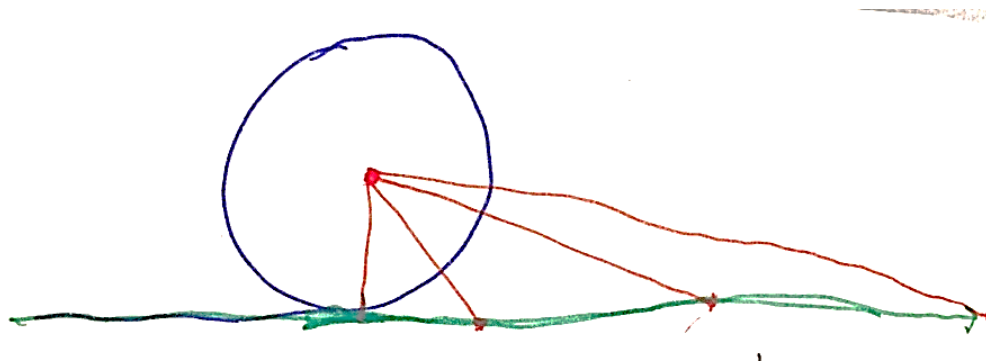

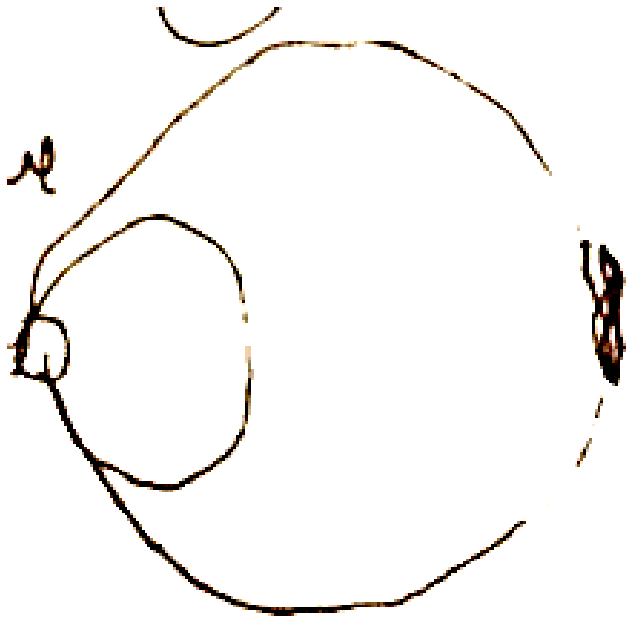
# Soul circle and body line
