
oCIRCLE: what does it mean?

Space: boundless, formless, place.


Point: bindu (tig-le), also seed.

<u>Radius</u>: Each human being is a unique ray of the divine and has their own perspective.



Among the many symbols used in astrological lore, the circle--for the Greeks the most perfect of the geometrical forms--in its appearance resembles zero, sunya or the void for the Buddhists. This form, like the others, perpetuates those properties that make it especially suitable as a support for our thoughts in depicting those principles that Plotinus spreads out before us in his writings. Difficulties that constantly arise have to do with the incredible wealth of meanings that develop as the web of interconnections and relations pyramid. There is an Infinite Community Of Light. This is the paradox, that the Overself is at once universal and individual. It is the first because it overshadows all as a single power. It is the second because it is found by each within themselves.

O... It is both space and the point in space.

It is infinite Spirit and yet it is also the holy presence in everyone's heart. The point in the heart is a focus for meditation and also an experience during meditation. ...when you meditate and penetrate and realize yourself in the heart, if you go one more step beyond that, then you aren't anyplace. You can't locate yourself. That's your center. That's your true center. But if you think that you are this body, and you say my center is here, then that's not it. One's real center is a state where there is no reference to any center. That's what you really are like. How could the mind have a center anyplace?

....Take away that center, take away that referent to itself all the time, and you get this feeling of an impersonal being that you are, this egoless being that you are. Let that referent come back in and you'll see that everything gets centered again in this dualistic way. But as long as you're referring to yourself as the center, you're going to have the opposite, the non-center. As long as you refer to this as the ``I am" or the ``me", there's the ``not-me" out there. I'm sure he has other quotes like that, which would clarify what he means by center.

There is a universal order, a way which Nature (God) has of arranging things. This is why what we see around us as the world expresses all-pervading meaning, intelligence, and purpose. But we catch only a mere hint of these veiled qualities-the mystery which recedes from them is immeasurably greater. 26.1.82

The circumference of the circle indicates the boundary of our life--the protective limits of the sacred alchemical retort of the mind wherein experience can be understood--as well as the evolving understanding of life's meaning. When we reverse the direction, there is a sense of the deepening movement to grasp our core or essence. Bv integrating the center and circumference we encompass the completeness of our humanity.
