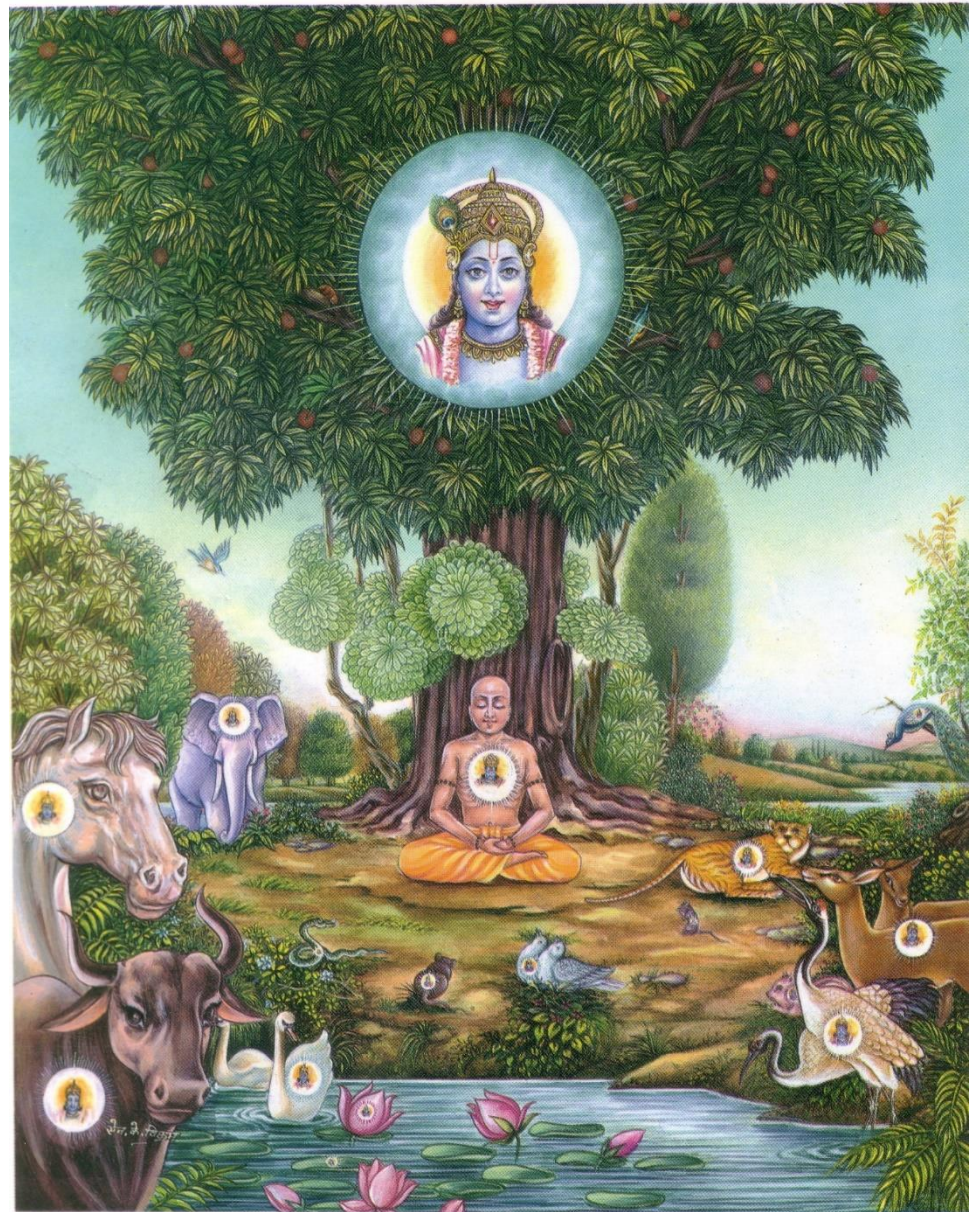

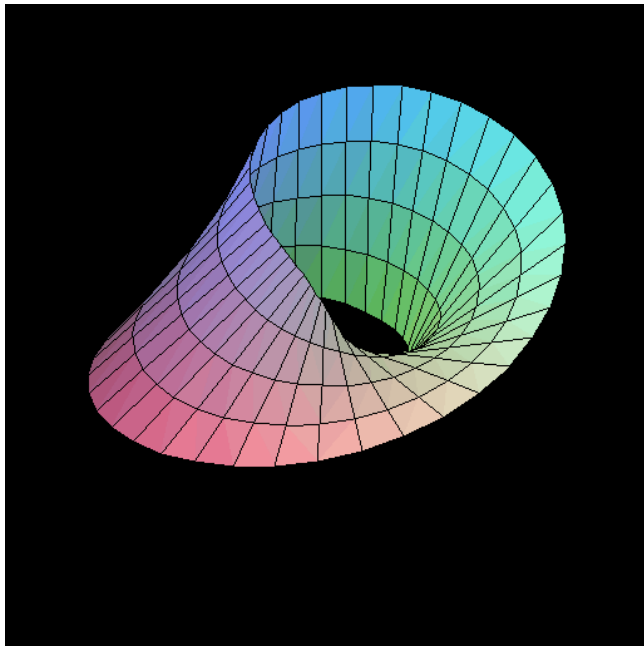

WAVING

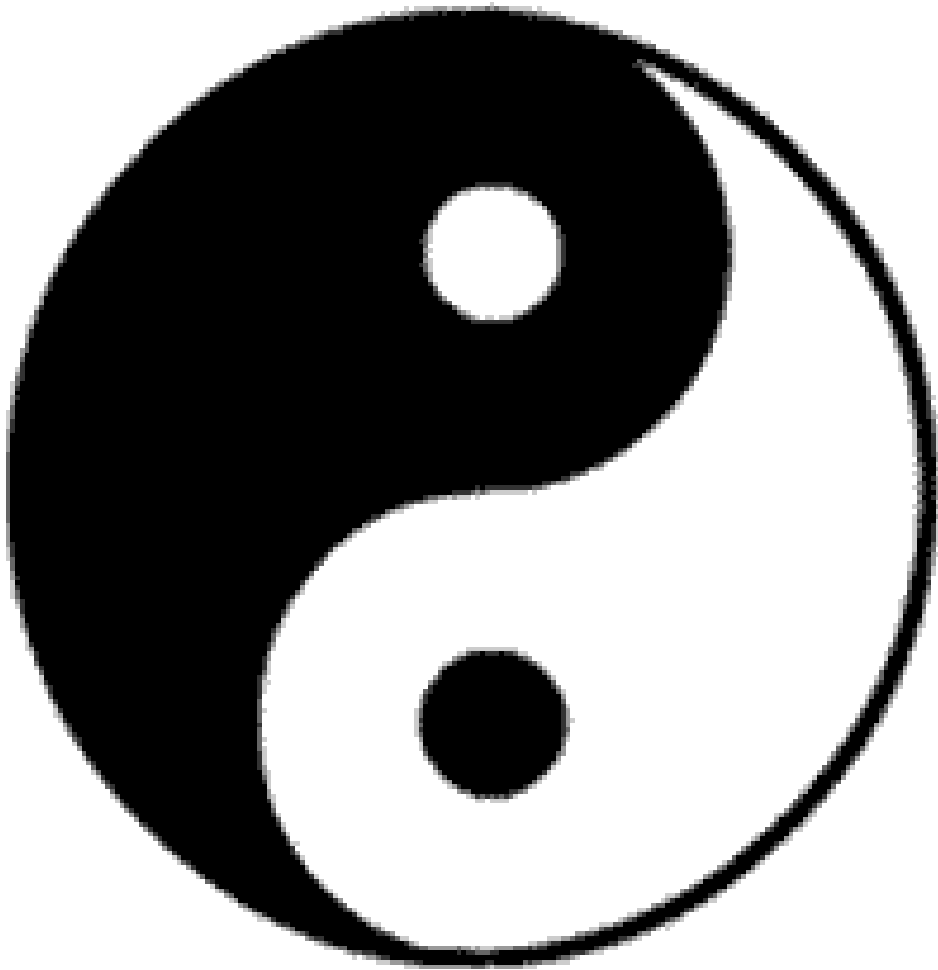


***As waves come with water and flames with fire,

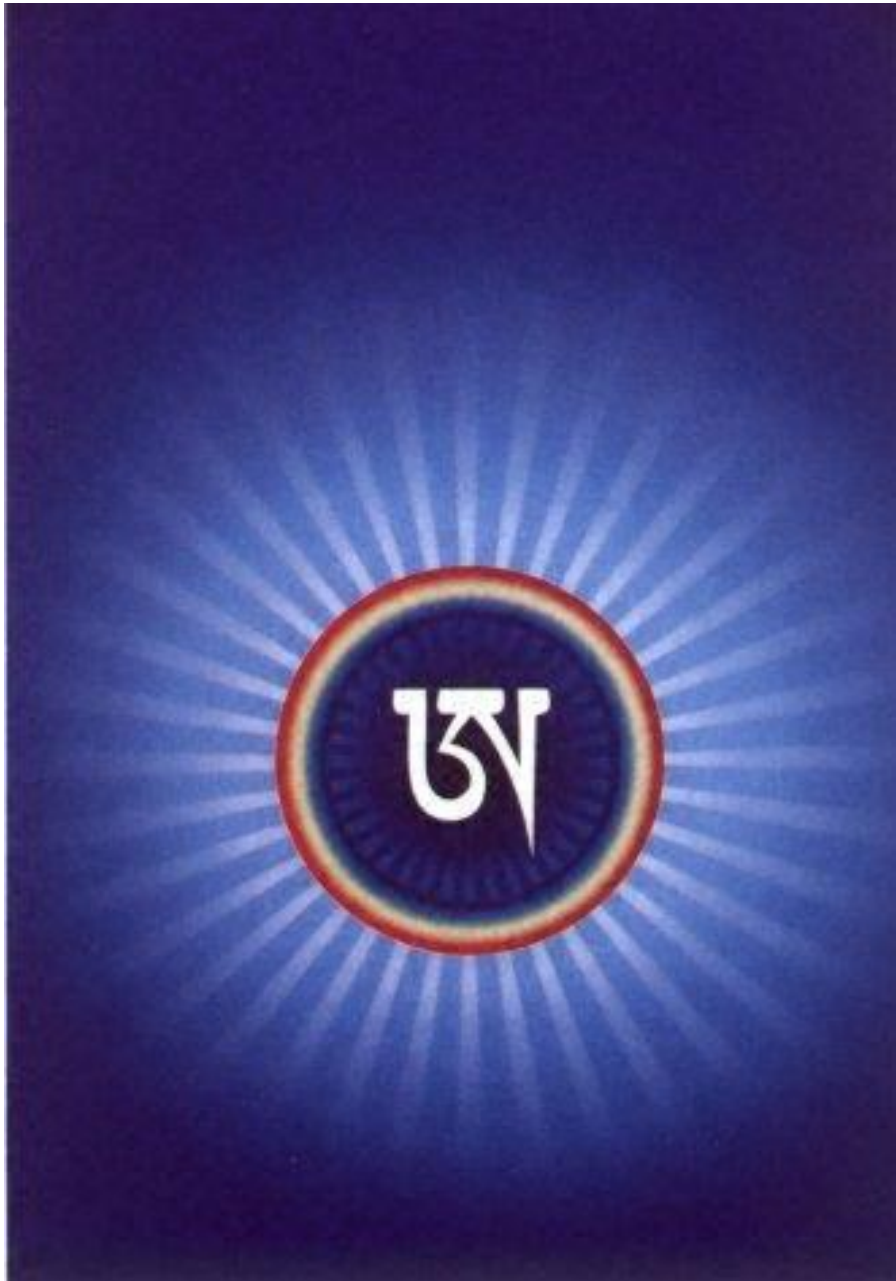

It teaches the individual in its uniqueness entirety and totality.

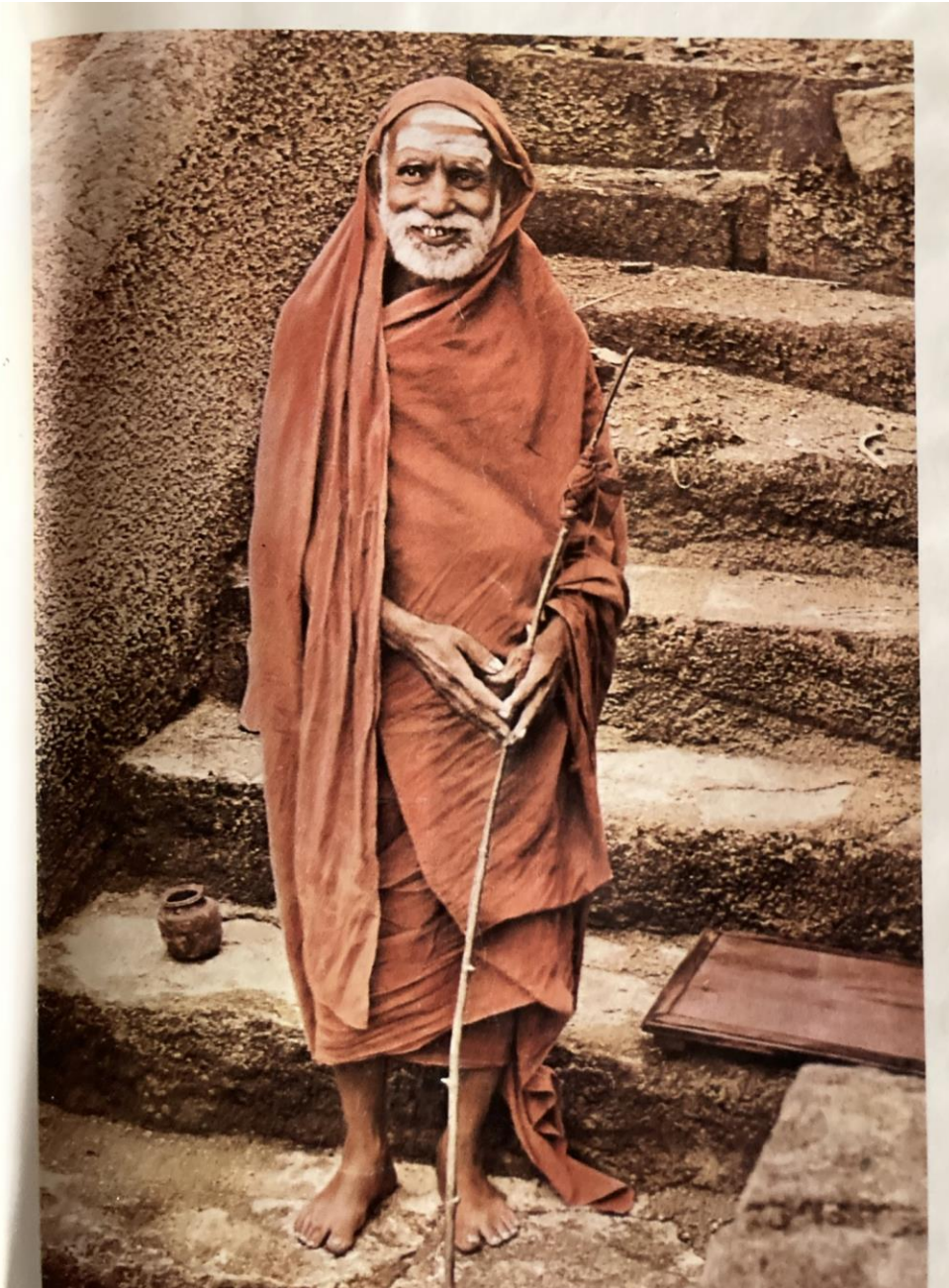
It teaches how to find and recognize oneself
